MSPCC's Kid's Net offers telephone support for all DCF licensed foster, kinship, and pre-adoptive families from 5 p.m. to 9 a.m. on weekdays and 24 hours/day on the weekends and holidays. The Helpline is staffed by social workers who are experienced with foster care issues and can help in non-emergency circumstances when DCF offices are closed.
